The mission of the Board of Overseers is to enhance the involvement, engagement and financial commitment of the community in support of the mission of South Shore Conservatory.

You have been invited to join the Overseers because we recognize within you the qualities of a leader for SSC. Your skills, talents and belief in the transformative powers of the arts are essential to our organization.

The primary governing responsibility of an Overseer is to elect both Trustees and Overseers, generally at SSC's Annual Meeting held on the second Wednesday evening in November. Overseers are elected to a term of three years and are eligible for reelection. There are no term limits for Overseers.

All Overseers are expected to help ensure that SSC has the resources necessary to succeed. It is expected that the annual minimum contribution for Overseers will be \$500, although many give more.

Overseers serve as ambassadors for SSC by raising awareness of the school and its mission within our communities. It is expected that Overseers will support SSC by attending and promoting its programs and events, including concerts, student and faculty performances, fundraisers, and press events. Overseers are encouraged to introduce new friends to SSC by inviting them to at least two SSC events a year.



Overseers also assist in identifying prospective new Overseers to ensure the health, growth and stability of the organization.

Overseers are active volunteers at SSC through donation of their time, resources, skills and talents. The many ways in which they participate include volunteering at events, concerts and recitals, soliciting donations for fundraisers, coordinating receptions, and responding to staff requests for assistance or resources.

Overseers are also eligible to serve as voting members of the standing committees of SSC's Board of Trustees, with the exception of the Executive Committee and the Governance and Nominating Committee. The Chair of each committee is responsible for appointing committee members, including Overseers.

An electronic copy of the complete Overseers manual will be sent to you upon your election at the Annual Meeting in November.
